Adverbios: Today, at the momento, at this momento, right now, now, just now, these days, these weeks, at six o'clock

Adverbios: for, Always never, often, recently, already, yet, just, since, ever, how long

Adverbios: Yesterday, last week. Last year, last month, two days ago, two weeks ago, in 2012, in September, the day before, the previous day, frases con when o while
